I would greatly appreciate your advice and support in the matter Public Education in the state of NSW. I have worked for the NSW Department of Education and Training for over 20 years, and have never witnessed such a low ebb, in both the provision of educational support nor the morale of my colleagues, in my area of expertise, Teacher Librarianship. Additionally, never has there been such poor leadership at school level, where self-interest seems to have taken precedence over educational standards. And apparently with the support of the Department of Education and Training.

I have attached a copy of an extract of a government document, Questions on Notice, that a colleague has provided input for the attention of the Minister for Education and Training, with the assistance of the Green Party.

Last week, I emailed the Minister for Education and Training on different - although related - matters to those in the Questions on Notice attached. I have not yet received any response, but I fear that any reply will be vacuous and meaningless, and will not produce any change. I have an online version on my website that is showing a large number of 'hits'; but beyond the interest shown by my colleagues in the state, nationally and internationally, I do not believe that there yet is any interest from any member of State Government.
